FAQs

Ques Why am I not allowed to bring guests on my enlistment day?

Ans In light of Ministry of Health (MOH)'s additional measures announced on 24 Mar 2020, parents / guests will not be invited on the enlistment day. This is to reduce crowding during enlistment and ensure safe distancing for your own safety as well as that of other recruits.

Ques **Do I stay in or stay out?**

Ans It will depends if you have a stay in excuse. If you have a stay in excuse, you will not need to stay in and you will book out on your enlistment day. You may view your excuses via NS Portal under ehealth.

Ques How do I find out what are my excuses?

- Ans Recruits may login to their NS portal under e-health to view their excuses. Following are the steps
 - 1. Go to Safhealth.gov.sg
 - 2. Log in with Singpass (on Main Page)
 - 3. Click View Military Info (Pes Status will be instantly viewable)
 - 4. Click on link under MC No. Column to view individual excuse.

Ques How long is the confinement?

Ans Confinement is during the 1st weekend.

Ques How long is BMT?

Ans BMT comprises of 2 phases.

BMT Phase 1 is 4 weeks basic soldiering followed by 4 weeks vocational phase and 1 week preparation for Graduation Parade.

Ques Can I charge my handphone?

Ans Recruits may bring power bank to charge your handphone during admin time.

Ques How many days of leave do I have?

Ans Leave will be pro-rated and the recruits are entitled 11 days this year inclusive of 5 days block leave.

Ques When is my first book out?

Ans Good Friday falls on 10 April hence the first book out is on 09 April (Thurs).

Ques What time is book in/out?

- Ans It will depends on the training programme and the recruits will be informed one day in advance.
- Ques My medicine requires to be chilled, is there any refrigerator which I can safely put my medicine?
- Ans Yes, there is a refrigerator which is for medical purposes.

Ques I have food allergies. Will there be food catered for me?

Ans Yes, we have meals which are for recruits who have food allergies

Ques Can I bring camera phone to camp?

Ans Yes, recruits are allowed to bring camera phone but they are not allowed to take pictures/videos within camp premises.
