A modern-day marketplace with a difference – will you barter or buy? Local creatives and small businesses offer an eclectic assortment of goods and services available for trade or purchase, inspired by the itinerant hawkers of historic port cities.

Each booth will offer options to either purchase goods or services, or to barter based on conditions set by the individual vendor. Limited supplies per day!

How it works:

- Each of the booths will have options available to barter or buy:
 - To buy: Selected goods or services are available for purchase. Payment methods: PayNow/PayLah!.
 - To barter: Goods/services for barter are available on a trade basis, where individual vendors will set their own ‘Acceptable Barter Items’. Bring along these items to trade with them!
 - Read their conditions carefully to avoid disappointment!
- Limited items available daily. Come early to avoid disappointment!
- Please note that the participating vendors may vary daily, check the schedule below.
