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What is ITE EAE





What is ITE EAE?

ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) allows you to apply for ITE courses based on your **aptitude and interests**, before taking your GCE N-Level or O-Level exams. If you are successful in the EAE, you will receive a conditional offer for admission to ITE.

Who is it for?

ITE EAE (2024 intake) is for you if you are:

- Taking your GCE N-Level or O-Level exams in 2023
- Keen to pursue your studies in an ITE course
- Passionate with strong aptitude related to the course

ITE EAE may not be suitable for you if you are still unsure about your course of choice. You may want to further explore your interests, and apply for courses at ITE only after your GCE N-Level or O-Level exams.

Note: Students with confirmed ITE EAE offers will not be eligible to participate in other ITE admissions exercises, except for Sec 4N(A) students who are eligible for the Direct Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP).

Prepare for your application

- Prepare the write-up (up to around **100 words**) for each course you are applying for. Express your passion for the course in your write-up. Include your relevant skills/activities/experiences that demonstrate your aptitude for the course
- You can prepare your write-ups in advance using the template from <https://for.edu.sg/eae-template>.

If shortlisted, prepare for an interview

- Bring along supporting documents, e.g. portfolio of related works, evidence of relevant experiences, and CCA records to the interview

What are the selection criteria?

If you are shortlisted, you will be informed to attend an interview and will be assessed through:

- Portfolio of related projects
- Participation in relevant MOE Applied Learning Modules and Applied Subjects
- Participation in work attachments, community/volunteer work, school/personal activities/projects, CCAs and competitions related to the course, such as ignITE Skills Challenge
- Aptitude tests (if applicable)

For course-specific criteria, refer to the ITE EAE application webpage.

Do my exam results matter under EAE?

After accepting the course offered under ITE EAE in Aug 2023, your GCE N-Level or O-Level exam results must meet the **Minimum Entry Requirements (MER)** of the course. Otherwise, the conditional course offer under ITE EAE will be revoked.

What is the timeline?



Step 1: Application Phase (24 May - 30 May 2023)

Interested students can submit their applications on www.ite.edu.sg/apply-eae.



Step 2: Interview Phase (20 Jun - 27 Jul 2023)

Shortlisted applicants will have to attend interviews and/or aptitude tests/portfolio assessment. The interviews may be conducted either on-campus or virtually via Microsoft Teams.



Step 3: Offer & Acceptance Phase (21 Aug - 25 Aug 2023)

Conditional offers will be made to successful applicants.

Applicants are required to accept the offer on ITE website by 25 Aug 2023.

Applicants who accept the offer will be guaranteed a place in ITE if their GCE N-Level or O-Level exam results meet the MER of the offered course.



Step 4: Withdrawal Phase (28 Aug - 4 Sep 2023)

Applicants who accept the conditional offer but later wish to withdraw from ITE EAE must submit their withdrawal request to training@ite.edu.sg by 4 Sep 2023.

Applicants who have accepted the ITE EAE offer and do not withdraw by the deadline, will have the conditional offers automatically confirmed if they meet the MER of the offered courses after the GCE N-Level or O-Level results are released.

ITE Early Admission Exercise (ITE EAE)

What is it?

Early Admissions Exercise

The Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) is an **aptitude-based admissions exercise**.

It gives the ITE greater flexibility to select and admit students on criteria other than their academic grades, thus allowing a wider range of talents to be recognised.

Why should your child go for the EAE?

Allows students to apply and receive **conditional offers for admission** to the **2-year Nitec** and **3-year Higher Nitec** courses in ITE based on their **aptitudes and interests, prior to receiving their final grades**.

Meet the course-specific Minimum Entry Requirements (MER) for the ITE course you have been offered under ITE EAE* for the conditional offers to be confirmed

ITE Early Admission Exercise (ITE EAE)

Selection

All shortlisted students **will be interviewed**. Students must prepare for the interview and **not go to 'TRY THEIR LUCK'**.

Things to look out for:

- 1) Students' aptitude and interest in a field related to the diploma course they are applying for.
- 2) Their confidence during the interview: how passionate they are about the course and how much they know about the course they are applying for.
- 3) ITE may also consider students' participation in activities such as work attachments, ApLM modules and projects that are related to the course students are applying for.

FULL-TIME 3-YEAR HIGHER NITEC / 2-YEAR NITEC COURSES AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR JIE 'N'

From Academic Year 2022, ITE offers a new curricular structure in selected courses that allows students to directly graduate with a *Higher Nitec* qualification after three years of training, instead of four years. The 3-year *Higher Nitec* courses are open to students with GCE 'N' Level and GCE 'O' Level qualifications.

Under JIE 'N', applicants may choose up to a maximum of 12 choices, which can include 3-year *Higher Nitec* courses together with 2-year *Nitec* courses in the same application. Each choice will comprise the course and College, e.g. *Nitec* in Mechanical Technology course conducted at ITE College East and *Nitec* in Mechanical Technology course conducted at ITE College West are taken as 2 choices. *Higher Nitec* in Accounting (3 years) course conducted at ITE College Central and *Nitec* in Aerospace Technology course conducted at ITE College Central are also taken as 2 choices.

The "2023 JIE 'N' ITE Aggregate Point" in the table below shows the ITE aggregate score of the lowest ranked students who were admitted to these courses through the 2023 JIE 'N', based on **best 4 GCE 'N' subjects including pre-requisites and bonus points**. These aggregate scores are meant as a reference for applicants applying to these courses and **do not** constitute the admission points for subsequent admission exercises.



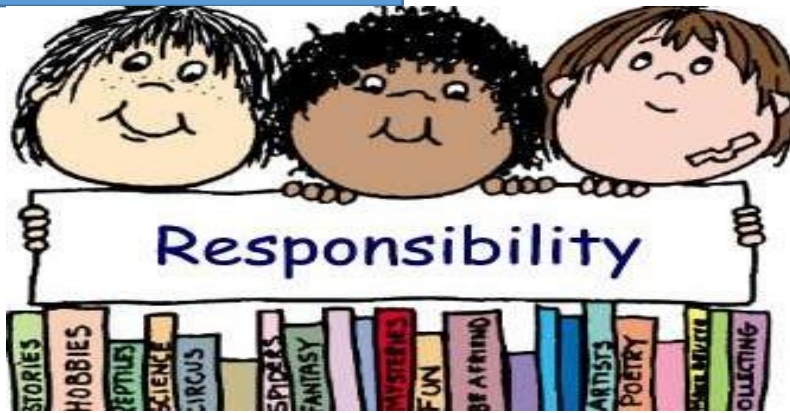

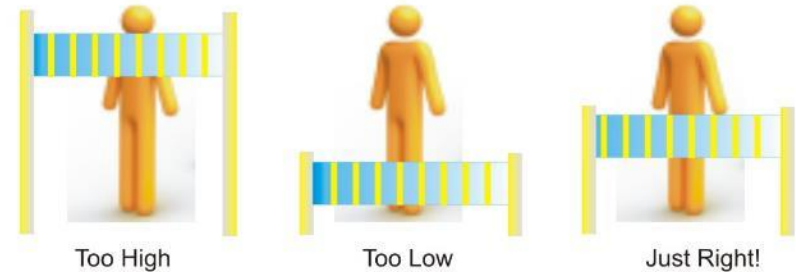
