Application Procedure

1. Application for DSA-Sec can be submitted through the online DSA-Sec Portal. You have from **11am on Tuesday, 7 May 2024 to 3pm on Monday, 3 Jun 2024** to submit your child's application.

2. Parents and students are encouraged to choose schools wisely based on the student's aptitudes and strengths, bearing in mind the schools' academic and non-academic requirements, and the programmes available to develop the respective Talent Area.
3. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted/given an offer.
4. Shortlisted applicants will be invited for a one-day face-to-face interview and audition/trial session in our school between **8 July 2024 to 2 August 2024**. Shortlisted applicants will be informed of the date and time of their interview and audition/trial session at least 2 weeks in advance.
5. All applicants will be notified of the application outcome by **9 September 2024**.
6. Students who are successfully admitted to the school via DSA are expected to honour their commitment to the school and participate in the activities related to the talent they are selected for from years 1-4.
