MER for entry into the 3-year *Higher Nitec* in Nursing:

N-Level

Career Conversion 3 GCE 'N' Level Passes (Grade A-D or Grade 1-5) in English Language, Mathematics and one other subject OR

O-Level:

2 GCE 'O Level Grades (Grade 1-8) in any two subjects OR

Employability Skills (ES) Workforce Skills:

Workplace Literacy and Numeracy (WPLN) Level 5 for all of the following: Reading, Listening, Writing, Speaking and Numeracy.

Individuals who have sat for GCE O/N-level but do not meet the above Academic Entry Requirements may still be considered.

Your application will be assessed holistically, and any of the following relevant prior training or work experience will be taken into consideration when assessing your application:

- ITE Skills Certificate (ISC) in Health Care (Inpatient/Outpatient/Home Care/Clinic Practice) with a minimum GPA of 2.8
- WSQ Advanced Certificate in Healthcare Support (Nursing Care) AND Minimum 3 years fulltime direct patient nursing care experience






