- [2] Does not apply to publicly traded shares in listed companies
- [3] For non-publicly listed companies, refer to individuals with shareholding per ACRA profile

- Food Manufacturing Associate: 3 months comprising facilitated classroom training (3 modules\*) and structured On-the-Job Training (OJT)

OJT and classroom training plan will have to be validated and endorsed by Singapore Polytechnic (SP) before the commencement of CCP training.
