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

Degree Requirements

Core contents are guided by Singapore Nursing Board (SNB) guidelines for curriculum accreditation of pre-registration nursing programmes.

Two-year full-time course incorporating core nursing courses and the clinical practicum.

- Programme consists on 18 CORE nursing courses (74 units)
- 32 weeks (32 units) of clinical practicum
- Advanced Placement Credits for 16 Units can be given for the unrestricted elective requirement (16 units)
