Booking and Programme Information:

How can I make a booking?

 To make a booking, please use NHB's central booking portal: BookMuseums. Bookings should be made at least 6 weeks in advance. It's recommended to log in with your Singpass for ease of access. For any queries or assistance, feel free to contact NHB_Digital_Services@nhb.gov.sg.

How many pax can be booked under 1 account?

 Depending on class size, a maximum of 30 pax can be booked per programme, subject to availability. There is no limit to how many bookings one account can make.

What is the cost per child and adult?

• The programme cost per child varies between \$5 and \$8 for self-guided programmes and \$15 to \$20 for facilitated programmes. Accompanying adults, up to 15 pax, will be free of charge. For international schools or schools not registered under ECDA, admission fees apply.

Is there any waiver for teachers?

Yes, teachers and accompanying adults up to 15 pax will be free of charge.
 Additional adults will have to pay programme fees according to the programme booked. For international schools or schools not registered under MOE/ECDA, admission fees apply.

What programmes are suitable for certain age groups?

- For children aged 4 and below, we recommend the Self-Guided Visit: Little Explorer's Adventure & Learning Journey: Little Time Travellers.
- For 5 and 6 years old (K1-K2), we offer a fully facilitated programme, Workshop: Let's Ship and Shop. Additionally,
- for 5 years to 9 years old (K1 to P3), we have two facilitated programmes: Spice Quest and WonderBot's Garden Party.

I see that your programme is for 5yo and above. Can my 4yo sign up for the programme?

 Our programme content and materials are designed for children aged 5 and above. However, teachers can exercise discretion to determine the suitability of the programme content for younger children based on their developmental stage.

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What does it mean if my booking status is "Pending"?

- When your booking status is marked as "Pending," it means that your visit is not yet confirmed. This status depends on the availability of our docents, who guide the tours.  Unfortunately, our museum exhibit and space are designed primarily for 12year-olds and may not be suitable for students with special needs. We suggest considering other museums with more suitable content and facilities for your students.

What is the maximum number of pax per session?

 Each session can accommodate up to 100 pupils and teachers. However, depending on the programme, there may be different capacity limits. If you have 1-5 more pupils than the stated number, kindly go ahead to make a booking and indicate under remarks the actual number of pupils or send an email to nhb_cmsg_edu@nhb.gov.sg.

Payment:

Do I have to pay once I make a booking?

 Payment will be processed after the museum visit. Schools will be billed based on the actual number of pupils and adults present on the day of the visit. Once a booking is made, a school billing form will be sent via email. Kindly fill out the form and send it back to nhb.gov.sg for invoicing purposes.

Can I request a quotation?

• Upon successful booking on the portal, you will receive an email with the programme costs. This email can be used as a quotation. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide official quotations separately.
