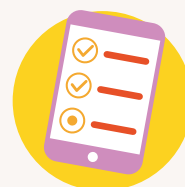

Through the collaboration between Singapore Prison Service and Family Service Centres (FSCs) in Apr 2022, the support was extended to all other female inmates and their family members, bridging the gap between families, and providing them with timely support and assistance from FSCs.

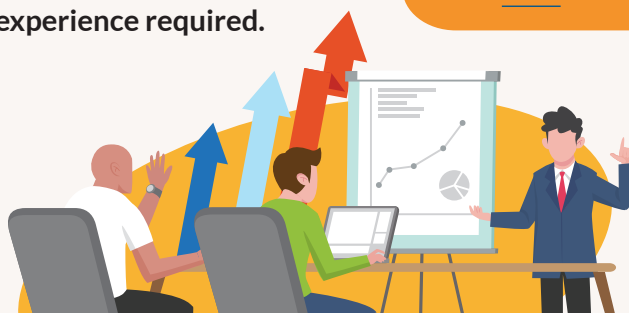
WSQ Counselling Skills Training (SkillsFuture Credits Eligible)

The festival also showcased band performances by desistors, sales of YR food and merchandise, and art workshops for the public.
