

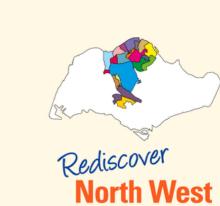

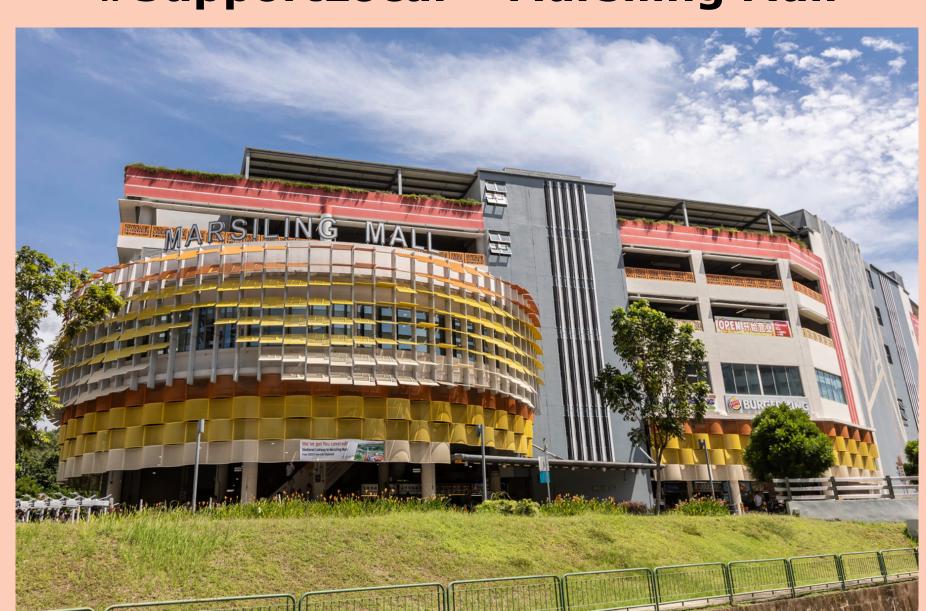
Rediscover North West
