

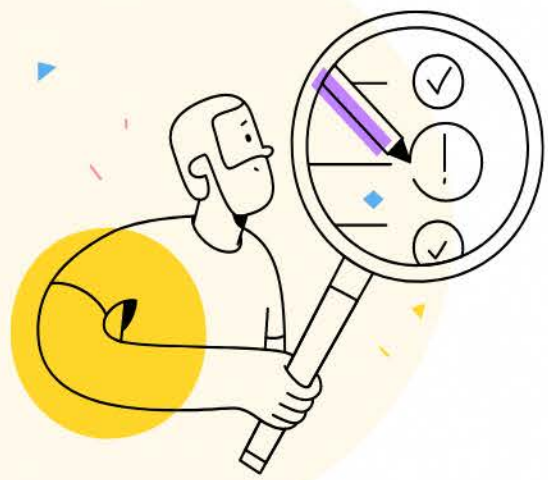

✗ MYTH #1 | HCA IS A TRAINING



The purpose of HCA is to determine whether the **Halal Team Leader** and **Halal Assurance Officer** are competent to perform their duties related to Halal compliance.



HCA is an assessment, not a training.

✗ MYTH #2 | ATTENDING TRAINING IS COMPULSORY



Choose between training or self-study.

If you choose to self-study to prepare for HCA, there are **free resources** available for you!

Training is optional.

✗ MYTH #3 | THERE IS NO NEED TO STUDY FOR HCA



Just like any other test, **studying is key** to passing HCA. This will ensure that you have the necessary knowledge to lead your team.



It is important to prepare and study before sitting for HCA.

✗ MYTH #4 | EVERYONE IN THE COMPANY NEEDS TO PASS HCA



Not all employees are required to pass the HCA. Only personnel who were previously required to attend the Halal Foundation Programme (HFP) need to pass the HCA.
