

MOE Financial Assistance Scheme

1. The income eligibility criteria for the MOE FAS has been revised as follows:-
- a) The family's gross household income (GHI) is \$3,000 and below per month or
 - b) The family's per capita income (PCI) is \$750 and below per month.

The benefits for the MOE FAS for Singapore citizen students are summarized below:

School Meal Subsidy^	Subsidy for 10 meals per 5-day school week from the month of approval, up to 40 weeks per annum	Not applicable
Bursary	Not applicable	\$1,200 per annum
*If the FAS application approval is not from January, the transport subsidy will be pro-rated accordingly from the month of approval after application is approved to December of the same year. ^Subsidies for school meals purchased and consumed in school.
