

Information For 4N(A) Students

(Educational Pathways)

Progression to Secondary 5NA

Students can be progress to Sec 5NA if they satisfy **ALL** the following criteria:

- ✓ Obtained ELMAB3 ≤ 19 , (ELMAB3 refers to the aggregate score of English Language, Math and best 3 other subjects)
- ✓ Obtained at least an N(A)-Level Grade 5 for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3.

Please meet Mrs Goh-Kok Mei Leng at the front of the hall if you have 18 or 19 points for ELMAB3

Application to enter Sec 5N(A)

- Obtain the Application Form from your Form Teacher.
- Students who are applying for PFP/DPP are to also submit the Sec 5NA application form with indication of PFP/DPP application on the form.

Deadline for Submission: Wednesday 20 Dec 2023 by 2pm (Sign on name list after submission at General Office)

Release of Results: Friday 22 Dec 2023 by 10am (Your FTs will inform you.)

Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

Students may apply for the DPP if they satisfy <u>ALL</u> the following criteria:

- √ Obtained ELMAB3 ≤ 19 (excluding CCA bonus points)
- √ Met subject-specific entry requirements for each course
 - Students accepted into the DPP will enrol into two-year Higher Nitec courses at ITE, and are subsequently guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their Higher Nitec if they meet the Grade Point Average (GPA) requirements.
 - Successful applicants will be required to attend a 10-week preparatory course prior to commencing their Higher Nitec courses.

Application to DPP

- Refer to Admission Booklet for instructions on application.
- All DPP-eligible students may submit an application online via the ITE website (https://www.ite.edu.sg).
- For SBB students, you may submit an application using both your GCE N-Level results, and results from the school-based preliminary examinations for O-level subjects.

(Upon the release of the O-Level examination results in Jan 2024, ITE will verify if applicants who had used school-based preliminary examination results for admission have fulfilled the criteria for admission to the DPP.)

- All students who are interested in DPP should also apply for Sec 5NA.
- Should you accept a DPP offer, you are <u>not</u> required to return for Sec 5NA.
- Inform your Form Teachers when you have accepted the DPP offer.

Release of Results: Friday 22 Dec 2023 at 2pm
Check results via the ITE application portal with web ID and password

Acceptance of Course Offer Period: Friday 22 Dec 2023 (2pm) to Wednesday 27 Dec 2023

Accept course offer via the ITE application portal with web ID and password

All applications are to be submitted ONLINE.

Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

Students may apply for PFP if they satisfy <u>ALL</u> the following criteria:

- √ Obtained ELMAB3 ≤ 12 (excluding CCA bonus points)
- √ Met the subject-specific entry requirements for the courses (must attain Grade 3 or better in all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3)
 - PFP is a diploma-specific foundation programme conducted over two academic semesters at the polytechnic by polytechnic staff.
 - Following the release of the GCE O-Level results in January, eligible students will submit the application online via the PFP portal.

For students who are ONLY interested in PFP

- Apply for Sec 5N(A) first and apply for the PFP in January 2024.
- If PFP application is successful, students will withdraw from Sec 5 by the end of January 2024.
- All PFP-bound students are required to attend classes up till the last Friday of January 2024, i.e. 26 January 2024.

Being eligible to apply for the PFP does not guarantee a successful placement into a PFP course.

Students who are interested to apply both PFP & DPP:

Option 1

- Apply for Sec 5NA and DPP first.
- Should you accept a DPP offer by Wed 27 Dec 2023, you will not need return to GSS for Sec 5N(A).
- Upon the release of the GCE O-Level results in January, you may apply for the PFP. If you are offered and accept a PFP place, you will then withdraw from DPP.

Option 2

- Apply for Sec 5NA first.
- Upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January, you may then apply for the PFP and DPP concurrently.
- If your application is successful, you will withdraw from 5N(A) by the end of Jan.

- ➤ Application period: Friday 29 Dec 2023 (9am) to Wednesday 3 Jan 2024
- ➤ Application results: Wednesday 10 Jan 2024 at 9am

(If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered in Phase 1 <u>before</u> applying in Phase 2.)

Phase 3 (for courses still with vacancies)

- ➤ Application period: 10 18 Jan 2024 and 24 Jan 7 Feb 2024
- ➤ Application results: 15 24 Jan 2023 and 24 Jan 14 Feb 2024

JIE Application

- ✓ Print a copy of verification slip as proof of application.
- ✓ Remember your web ID and password view the results of your application.
- ✓ Keep Admission Booklet after submission of application instructions for acceptance and appeal.
- ✓ You are allowed to make changes to your application only once over the internet.

- ✓ Please check that all your personal particulars are correctly printed on the results slip and inform Mrs Goh Mei Leng / Ms Shirley Yong (at front of Hall) by today if particulars need to be amended.
- ✓ There will be an amendment fee of \$50 for any certificate that requires a reprint.


