Industry Overview (Brief description of the sector)	The Infocomm Technology (ICT) sector continues to play a key role in Singapore's economic development. According to the IMDA's Survey on ICT Manpower for 2019, the number of ICT professionals employed grew by 8,100 (4.3%) from 2017 to reach 197,500 in 2018. Together with 18,700 ICT job vacancies, total demand of ICT professionals increased by 6.7% from 2017 to reach 216,200 in 2018. Demand for ICT professionals is projected to grow by another 61,600 by 2021. ICT jobs are also in demand across sectors such as healthcare, education and financial services. Singapore is poised to become the world's first Smart Nation which aims to develop Singapore's capabilities in pervasive connectivity and build new infrastructure and common technical architecture to enable citizens, businesses and government agencies to leverage technology to make lives better. This initiative would increase the demand for ICT professionals in the areas of Software and Applications, Network and Infrastructure and Critical Emerging Technology.
