


PROGRESSION PATHWAY

From *Nitec* to *Higher Nitec* to Diploma



3-YEAR HIGHER NITEC

- Graduate with a Higher Nitec in 3 years
- Gain deeper industry skills (3 months IA in Year 2, and 6 months IA in Year 3)
- Get a stronger foundation for further education and skills education and skills upgrading



Addressing EITR on EAE (Part 1)

Or... 'Elephants in the Room' (Popular Questions by Prospective Students)

Why do students still need to meet the Minimum Entry Requirements if they have accepted the EAE offer?

While interest and passion is important, students must still be able to cope with the course of study at ITE. The results do indicate the necessary foundation for they to do so.

Can students who have accepted an EAE offer apply for polytechnic should they qualify for it?

Yes. The student can apply in the Joint Polytechnic Admissions Exercise and should he get an offer, he can withdraw from his ITE EAE course.

Can GCE N(A) Level students apply for Direct Entry Scheme to the Polytechnics (DPP) under EAE?

No. Students can only apply for DPP during the Joint Intake Exercise, after results are received.

Can students who have accepted the EAE offer change his mind?

If students do not withdraw after 1 September, they are deemed to have confirmed their conditional offer. They will not be able to change courses should they meet the Minimum Entry Requirements after receiving their results.

Addressing EITR on EAE (Part 2)

Or... 'Elephants in the Room' (Popular Questions by Prospective Students)

Can GCE N Level students who have accepted an EAE offer apply for DPP or Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) after receiving their results?

Yes. If a DPP offer is made, the student has to make a decision. As application to the PFP starts in Jan, students may progress to ITE first.

Does the EAE consider achievements in sports, performance and community service etc. in its assessment?

The ITE EAE is primarily targeted at aptitude and interest that is related to a *Nitec and Higher Nitec* course. Other submissions can be considered.

If I am not successful in the EAE, can I appeal?

No. Students can apply for the same course during the Joint Intake Exercise, upon receiving their exam results

Can GCE O Level students apply for the ITE EAE and Poly EAE at the same time?

Yes, if they are successful, they can hold onto both conditional offers until the release of their results. They will have to decide by then and we hope they will join us. :)

Addressing EITR on 3-Year Higher Nitec...

Or... 'Elephants in the Room' (Popular Questions by Prospective Students)

Can I change course after 2 years?

It is possible to switch course / specialisation after Year 1, subject to vacancy. However, they must remain within the same sector / cluster.

What is a key difference between the 2-Year *Nitec* and 3-Year *Higher Nitec* programme?

All students in the 3-Year Higher Nitec programme will undergo two industry attachment (IA) stints (a 3-month IA in Year 2 and a 6-month IA in Year 3). This is intended to better hone workplace competencies and deepen industry experience.

Are there more students applying for 3-Year HN and will there be more training places?

Indeed, more students are applying for the 3-Year HN, compared to N programmes. There will be similar number and distribution of training places, compared to the courses being replaced. The number of training places is allocated according to industry demand.

Is there a faster pathway in the 3-Year HN programme?

It is possible to complete the programme earlier, if the student gets a GPA of 3.7 or higher after the 1st semester of Year 1. There will be a 3-month bridging course to progress to semester 2 of Year 2. As such, the pathway will be 2 years and 3 months.
