Leadership in action workshop 20 May 2023

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1) Which levels should the student leaders be from?

The student leaders should be from Secondary 2 or 3 / JC 1 or 2. Schools should not be sending outgoing students who will be stepping down shortly.

2) Which appointments should the student leaders be holding?

It is recommended to send your Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson as well as the Tech for Good Champion and Emerging Tech Specialist. Please click <u>here</u> for details about these 2 new roles.

3) Can my Club send more than 4 students? (i.e register more than once with different names)

We aim to accommodate as many schools and Infocomm Media Clubs as possible so teachers should only register 4 student leaders per Club. Do note that registration is on a first-come-first-served basis.

You may however write in to indicate interest in sending more student leaders. We will contact you closer to the date should there be space for additional students from the same Club.

4) Do teachers need to be present at the workshop?

Teachers do not need to be present as IMDA staff will be at the workshop to ensure student safety. However, teachers who are required by their school to chaperone the students may stay on in a separate location at Nanyang Girls' High School. Do note that no teacher-centric programmes have been prepared as part of this workshop.

5) Is the workshop free of charge?

Yes, this workshop is complimentary and no payment is required.

6) Will meals be provided?

Only lunch and tea break will be provided. All meals will be halal certified and there is an option to indicate whether your student requires a vegetarian meal.

7) Will there be a RAMS form provided?

A RAMS form will not be provided but additional details will be sent by 10 May, including the programme for the day as well as the evacuation plan in the event of fire. There will not be any physically strenuous activities.

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8) Is participation at the Foundations of Leadership online workshops in February a prerequisite for attending this training in May?

No, it is not a prerequisite. Schools and Clubs which did not join in February are welcome to sign up for this workshop.

9) Does the kind of personal learning device my student leaders are using matter?

No, there is no specific kind of device that is required. Student leaders are required to bring their personal learning devices to take part in the hands-on activities which would be browser based and compatible across a range of devices.

10) Will there be an online livestream of the workshop?

The workshop will only be conducted face-to-face for participants at the venue.

11) Is this the equivalent of the Infocomm Media Club Student Leadership Conference that took place in July 2022 at Marina Bay Sands?

No, this is a training workshop and there will still be a separate Infocomm Media Club Student Leadership Conference taking place in October.

12) My CCA is not an Infocomm Media Club. Can we take part in the student leadership training?
