Punctuality for School

With Term 1 almost coming to an end, we have observed that most pupils have settled in well for the new academic year and are punctual for school.

However, we also observe some pupils reporting to school late, which causes them to miss important morning routines, announcements and part of the learning each day.

Our school has repeatedly reminded our pupils to be punctual for school, which means being physically present at the assembly area (e.g. school hall / classrooms etc) by 7.30am. This will allow them time to settle down before their school day commences.

With sufficient reminders given in Term 1, and enough time given for your child/ward to adapt to a new academic year, the school will begin recording our pupils' latecoming from Term 2 onwards. With effect from Monday 18 March 2024, pupils who are not physically present at the assembly area (e.g. school hall / classrooms etc) by 7.30am will be recorded as late.

Pupils who are recorded as late for school on 6 days or more in each term will have their latecoming data recorded in the Student Offence Module. Please note that this may cause your child/ward to receive a 'Fair' or 'Poor' conduct grade, which may affect his/her eligibility for awards, scholarships, bursaries etc.

Thank you for partnering us, and for ensuring that your child/ward reports to school punctually each school day.

Indiscriminate Parking

Our office has received numerous feedback regarding vehicles parking indiscriminately outside the school. While we understand the need of parents wanting to drop off / pick up their children, such inconsiderate parking had caused inconveniences, obstruction and danger to other road users.

For the safety of all road users, we would like to urge all drivers to exercise care and consideration by **not waiting or parking** at these critical areas:

- a) At road bends, entrances or exits of any access;
- b) Within 6 metres of a road junction;
- c) Within 9 metres of a bus stop;
- d) Parking abreast to another vehicle;
- e) At zebra-controlled/Pedestrian crossing area; and/or
- f) School Zone

Under the current Road Traffic Act, any of the above acts constitute to a parking offence. Upon receiving feedback of such occurrences, LTA will take enforcement action against vehicles found parking indiscriminately.

We strongly advise parents to arrive at school only when they are ready to perform the immediate pick-ups/drops offs. If there is a need to wait, we would advise you to park your vehicles at the nearby HDB car park compound which gives a grace period to avoid getting unnecessary fines in future.

Let us play our part to make the road safe for all road users.

We seek your partnership in educating your child/ward to be responsible for their personal items. As such, from 1 March onwards, the school <u>will not accede</u> to your request to pass any items (except medication) which your child/ward has forgotten to bring to school.

Arif Budiman Malay Language Teacher Award 2024

From 2 February to 1 April 2024, students, educators, parents, and members of the public are invited to nominate outstanding Malay Language teachers for the Arif Budiman Malay Language Teacher Award (AGAB) 2024.

Jointly presented by the Malay Language Council, Singapore, Malay Language Teachers Association, Berita Harian and the Malay Language Learning and Promotion Committee, the Arif Budiman Malay Language Teacher Award recognises Malay Language teachers from primary and secondary schools, junior colleges, and Millennia Institute who have made significant contributions to the teaching of the Malay Language.

Nominees will be evaluated based on their ability to:

- Instill knowledge, skills and interest in the learning of the Malay language, literature and culture, as well as their care and concern for the well-being of their students; and
- Demonstrate the values of Arif Budiman, a learned person who contributes to society through excellent and exemplary service as an educator.

Since 2007, the Awards have recognized 77 primary, secondary and pre-university Malay Language teachers. This year, awards will be given out under the following categories: (i) Motivation (less than 10 years in teaching service), and (ii) Role Model (10 years and above in teaching service).
