We are over 30,000 strong, with 46,000 NSmen and work in partnership with about 15,000 volunteers to keep Singapore **safe and secure**.

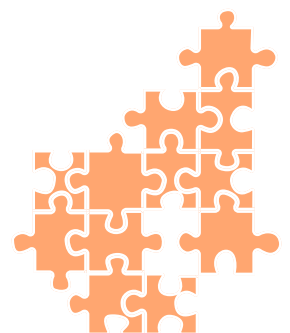
The Home Team comprises the Ministry Headquarters and 10 Home Team agencies, with one common mission - **Safeguarding our Home**.

## Uniformed Scholarships

The **Singapore Police Force Scholarship (SPFS)** is one of the most prestigious scholarships awarded by the Public Service Commission (PSC). Recipients of this scholarship will pursue a uniformed career with the Singapore Police Force.

MHA also offers an **MHA Uniformed Scholarship** for uniformed careers with the Singapore Police Force (SPF), Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF), Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA), Singapore Prison Service (SPS) and the Central Narcotics Bureau (CNB).

## What are my options if I am keen in a Science and Technology (S&T) career with the Home Team?

You can consider a career with our statutory board, HTX (Home Team Science and Technology Agency). As the Home Team's Force Multiplier, HTX works at the forefront of science and technology to empower our Home Team frontline in keeping Singapore safe.

## What are the value and benefits of an MHA Scholarship?

- Tuition and compulsory fees for undergraduate studies in a range of disciplines<sup>+</sup>
- Full salary<sup>#</sup>
- Maintenance allowance (overseas/local)
- Pre-study allowance<sup>^</sup>
- Vacation attachments
- Sponsored return flights for undergraduates studying abroad
- Sponsorship for university exchange programme and post-graduate degree<sup>#</sup>

<sup>+</sup>Students reading Medicine, Dentistry and Architecture are not eligible.

<sup>#</sup>If you pursue a Law degree, you will not be called to the Bar while serving in the Home Team.

## Am I eligible for an MHA Scholarship?

To be eligible for an MHA Scholarship, the following criteria would apply:

- Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident intending to take up Singapore Citizenship
- Strong leadership qualities and potential
- Good academic and co-curricular activities (CCAs) records
- GCE A-levels (10 AU), International Baccalaureate, Polytechnic, NUS High School, or other High School Diploma/Certificate

For MHA Mid-Term Scholarships, the following criteria would additionally apply:

- Currently pursuing full-time undergraduate studies and on track for graduation with at least 2nd Upper Honours or equivalent
- Have completed at least one semester and not in the final year of undergraduate studies at point of application



## Can I apply for an MHA Scholarship as a university undergraduate?

You can apply for a MHA Mid-Term Scholarship if you are a full-time undergraduate who is not in your final year of study and have at least one semester of university results. Tuition and compulsory fees you incurred before the award will be back-paid.

# What opportunities would I have as an MHA scholar?

We provide our officers with many opportunities to learn and develop professionally and personally!

Scholarship holders go through structured postings where they will build up varied knowledge and skills and acquire specialised capabilities. Scholars will be given developmental opportunities such as leadership and training programmes, and special projects to expand their horizons.

Eligible scholarship holders will be emplaced on the Public Service Leadership Programme or the Home Team Leaders-in-Development Programme, where they will be provided with developmental opportunities, and be groomed for key leadership positions within the Home Team and/or the wider Public Service.

# SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS



## How do I apply?

If you are keen on The Singapore Police Force Scholarship, MHA Uniformed Scholarship, MHA Civilian Scholarship or the PSC Scholarship (Engineering) - Defence & Security Cluster (HTX), apply via the PSC website ([psc.gov.sg/scholarships/undergraduate-scholarships/psc-scholarships](https://psc.gov.sg/scholarships/undergraduate-scholarships/psc-scholarships)). The application period opens on 1 September annually, and closes on 15 March of the following year. Please refer to the PSC website for the most up-to-date information on the timeline.

If you are keen on the HTX Scholarship, apply via the [brightsparks.com.sg/profile/htx/scholarship.php](https://brightsparks.com.sg/profile/htx/scholarship.php) microsite. The application period opens on 1 September annually, and closes on 15 March of the following year.

# What is the application process?

## SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

Apply for The Singapore Police Force Scholarship, MHA Uniformed Scholarship and MHA Civilian Scholarship via the PSC website ([psc.gov.sg/scholarships/undergraduate-scholarships/psc-scholarships](https://psc.gov.sg/scholarships/undergraduate-scholarships/psc-scholarships)).

Select from the following options on the PSC portal:

<b>1) Uniformed Services (Singapore Police Force)</b> (to apply for The Singapore Police Force Scholarship)	<b>2) Home Team (Uniformed)</b> (to apply for the MHA Uniformed Scholarship)
<b>3) Home Team (Civilian)</b> (to apply for the MHA Civilian Scholarship)	

Apply for the HTX Scholarship via the BrightSparks microsite: [brightsparks.com.sg/profile/htx/scholarship.php](https://brightsparks.com.sg/profile/htx/scholarship.php)

Apply for the PSC Scholarship (Engineering) - Defence and Security Cluster (HTX) via the PSC website ([psc.gov.sg/scholarships/undergraduate-scholarships/psc-scholarships](https://psc.gov.sg/scholarships/undergraduate-scholarships/psc-scholarships)). Select 'Engineering (D&S)' as your scholarship choice and choose HTX as your preferred parent agency when applying on the PSC portal.

## GO THROUGH SELECTION AND ASSESSMENT

If you are shortlisted, you will be invited to take a psychometric test to assess your general, verbal and numerical reasoning abilities and to provide a rounded view of your psychological profile.

At this point, you will receive an email from MHA to indicate your preferred Home Team Department or civilian career track.

## ATTEND THE BOARD INTERVIEW

At this stage, eligible candidates will be invited to attend a board interview with a panel of senior officers from various Home Team agencies.

## RECEIVE THE OFFER

If you reach this stage, you will receive a provisional scholarship offer.

Your scholarship will be confirmed after the completion of a series of administrative processes.

## ATTEND THE AWARD CEREMONY

Recipients will be invited to attend The Singapore Police Force Scholarship and MHA Scholarships Award Ceremony - a chance to celebrate this milestone in your career journey and meet with MHA Senior Management and fellow MHA scholars!

## How long is the bond period?

An MHA Scholarship will give you opportunities to study in world-class universities locally or overseas. Bond periods will vary depending on where you pursue your undergraduate studies. It will start on the day you assume official duty.

Local University	4 years
Overseas University (Non-English Speaking Countries)	5 years
Overseas University (English Speaking Countries)	6 years

## Am I eligible for an MHA Scholarship as a Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR)?

Yes, you are welcome to apply for an MHA Scholarship if you are intending to take up Singapore citizenship. You will need to take up Singapore citizenship in order for your award to be confirmed.

You have to be a Singapore Citizen to be eligible for The Singapore Police Force Scholarship.

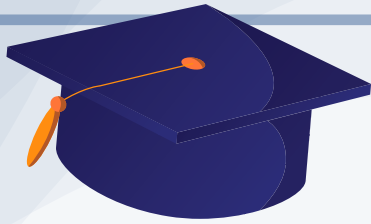

## How many scholarships will be awarded?

**We do not have a pre-determined quota.** Scholarships are awarded depending on the quality of applicants.

## What undergraduate courses can I read?

We accept scholarship applications to read most disciplines of study, except Medicine, Dentistry and Architecture. If you pursue a Law degree, you will not be called to the bar while serving in the Home Team.

For individuals aspiring to take up Specialist roles within the Home Team (i.e. Civilian Specialist Tracks or SCDF Paramedic), you should select a relevant discipline and course of study.

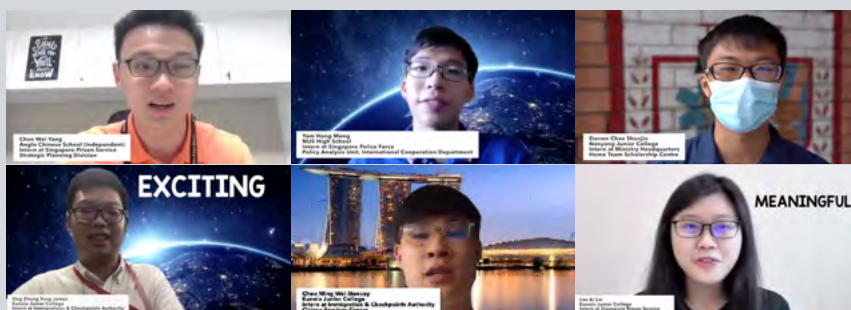

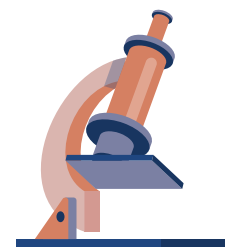
