Introduction to Grassroots Financial Accounting System (G-FAST) for Office Bearers

Grassroots Financial Accounting SysTem (G-FAST) is the new improved online accounting system replacing the PA Web-Based Accounting Template (PAT) used by 2,000 Grassroots Organisations (GROs) to prepare and submit their monthly accounts. G-FAST supports e-approvals and e-payments with in-built system controls designed to increase work efficiency, improve user experience and enhance compliance.

This course equips learners with the knowledge on how to 1) Create transactions such as Receipts, Transfers, Journals and Payments with Electronic Funds Transfer Mode; 2) Use reports to check the transactions; and 3) Perform bank reconciliation. Learners who are Approvers will learn how to approve payments and what to look out for before approving.
