DIPLOMA IN NURSING (PCP-RN)

General PCP Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident;
- Minimum age of 21 years;
- Graduated from full-time studies or completed National Service for at least two years (whichever is most recent), prior to the course commencement date

Other Entry Requirements:

- Bachelor degree from a recognised university in a discipline other than nursing; or
- Local polytechnic diploma in a discipline other than nursing; <u>or</u>
- 3 GCE 'A' level credits* with 2 GCE 'O' level credits^ in a Science subject and Mathematics

*GCE 'A' level credits refer to grades A to E ^GCE 'O' level credits refer to grades A1 to C6

Other Considerations

- Medical examination
- Physical, mental, visual and auditory ability
- Willing to work 3 rotating shifts, on weekends and public holidays.


