**PRIMARY 6 MID-YEAR REVISION EXERCISE**

We will be conducting the Mid-Year Revision Exercise in **Term 2 from Week 4 to Week 8**. The Mid-Year Revision Exercise is one among the different assessment types we use to monitor our students' learning progress and provide feedback for improvement. While it is non weighted and does not affect the student's overall Preliminary Examination results, it serves as a valuable timed-practice opportunity for our students to familiarise themselves and work within the expected duration of various assessment components and reflect on their experiences and outcomes.
