Please take note of the following:

1. Absence from Weighted Assessments and Examinations

1.1 Students are required to be present for all weighted assessments and examinations. Absence from assessment/examination must be covered by a medical certificate from qualified medical professionals who are registered with the Singapore Medical Council. Students are required to submit their medical certificate(s) to their form teachers on the day they return to school.

- 1.2 Students with valid medical/compassionate reasons for their absence from assessment/examination will be accorded VR (Valid Reason) for the subject. Marks will be pro-rated for the subject(s) accordingly.
- 1.3 No marks will be accorded to students who are absent **without** a valid reason or a medical certificate.
- 1.4 Examples of non-valid reasons include:
 - Truancy
 - Family matters (except for compassionate grounds)
 - External examinations such as piano and ballet examinations
- 1.5 There will be no make-up papers for all weighted assessments and examinations except for P6 Preliminary Examinations. Students must produce a medical certificate or have a valid reason to qualify for these examinations.
- 1.6 Students who are absent for weighted assessments and examinations will sit for the papers as practice when they are back in school. The marks will not be recorded in the report books.
- 2. Sitting for the Weighted Assessments and Examinations
- 2.1. Students are to be punctual for all assessments and examinations. Students who are late are allowed to sit for the remaining duration of the assessment and examination with no additional time given.
- 2.2. Students taking P5 & P6 Mathematics Paper 2 can only use approved calculator models for the assessments and examinations. https://www.seab.gov.sg/docs/default-source/documents/guidelines_calculators.pdf
- 2.3. Students taking P4 to P6 Mother Tongue Paper 1 (Composition) can only use approved dictionaries for assessments and examinations. https://www.seab.gov.sg/docs/defaultsource/documents/list_of_dictionaries_for_examination.pdf
- 2.4. A student's assessment and examination results may be subjected to penalties or accorded a score of zero if he/she engages in any of the following:
 - cheating, attempts to cheat, aids in cheating during assessments and examinations
 - misbehaves, or fails to comply with the assessment and examination regulations
 - attempts to cheat while the teacher is reviewing the marked papers in class or when the marked papers are taken home for parent's / guardian's signature

Additionally, the student will receive a 'Fair' conduct grade for the academic year.
