<b>Industry Overview :</b> (Brief description of the sector)	Singapore is home to over 30 global medical technology companies with commercial-scale plants to manufacture medical devices and high quality instruments for the regional and global markets. Singapore's medical technology sector contributes about S\$ 13.3 billion in output or 3.7% of Singapore's total manufacturing output in 2018. The sector employs around 16,000 people across manufacturing, R&D and HQ functions. Broadly, the medical technology sector includes medical devices, life science tools and reagents, cardiovascular, ophthalmic, and diagnostics.

Customised programmes are designed for different job roles, which are tailored to individual's development needs so as to equip them with the relevant skills and competencies for a successful career conversion.</p>
