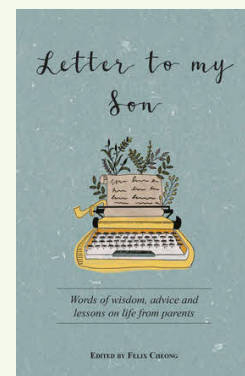
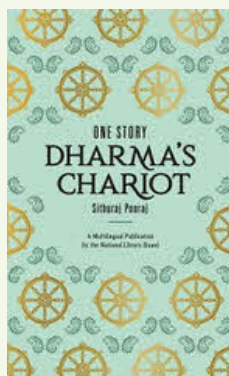
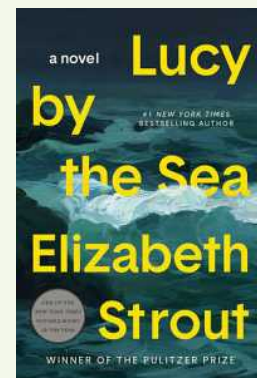
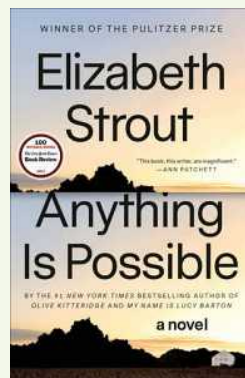
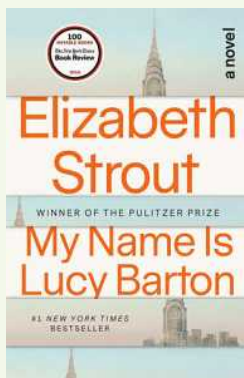
Oh William! by Elizabeth Strout
