

## ANNEX B: 6.2 Austrade Enterprise Singapore MOU to support a Green Business Partnership

<b>Area of Cooperation</b>	Engagements and Partnerships
<b>Purpose</b>	<p>Support businesses from both countries to leverage trade and investment opportunities between Singapore and Australia in areas of mutual interest under the GEA by pursuing joint projects that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Promote and facilitate trade and investment in priority green economy sectors; and</li> <li>• Facilitate business-to-business engagement and promotion of opportunities in the green economy in Singapore and Australia.</li> </ul>
<b>Description</b>	<p>The Australian Trade and Investment Commission (Austrade) and Enterprise Singapore (EnterpriseSG) will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to create a framework to support delivery of a Green Business Partnership which will promote stronger trade and investment links that support the objectives of the GEA, including through, but not limited to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Joint promotion of events and opportunities for business matching at third party events</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• e.g. Promotion of events and opportunities via EnterpriseSG and Austrade distribution channels, including via partners, to encourage participation by businesses from Singapore and Australia. Opportunities to explore sideline events for 1-1 business matching or support the conferences through identifying keynote speakers etc.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>2. Joint summits/webinars/seminars on green economy opportunities in Singapore and Australia</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• e.g. Co-organise two sectoral focused sharing sessions per year, one on opportunities in Singapore and one on opportunities in Australia</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>3. Business missions to Singapore and Australia respectively for green economy related conferences or visits</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• e.g. Jointly support business delegations around key green economy related conferences such as <i>Singapore International Energy Week</i>, <i>All Energy Australia Exhibition and Conference</i>, and <i>Green Hydrogen APAC</i>. Opportunities to explore sideline events for 1-1 business matching or support the conferences through identifying keynote speakers etc.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
<b>Governance Process</b>	<p>Lead agencies will continue to meet at least bi-annually to review the MOU and joint action plan to identify new topics and projects, such as carbon trading and services, that could be included into the action plan.</p> <p>Lead agencies will report on the activities and outcomes delivered through the MOU to the GEA Action Team.</p>
