SCHOOL HEALTH VISIT FOR PRIMARY 1 TO 6 STUDENTS

1. Health Promotion Board (HPB) will be conducting the annual school health visit at the school from **Monday, 30 October 2023 to Tuesday, 7 November 2023**. During this visit, age-appropriate health screening and/or immunisation services will be provided for your child/ ward as required.

Primary 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Vision screening (Eyesight test)▪ 3D vision screening▪ Growth & development assessment▪ Hearing screening▪ Immunisation if required
Primary 2, 3 and 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Screening (Vision screening)▪ Height and BMI for selected students
Primary 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Colour vision screening▪ Growth & development assessment▪ Spinal screening for scoliosis[#] (girls only)▪ Immunisation
Primary 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Spinal screening for scoliosis[#] (girls only)▪ Height and BMI for selected students

[#] Female students will be briefed before the check-up for scoliosis is done for each student in an enclosed area for privacy. During the check-up, the female student will be asked to show her back to the female doctor or nurse before being asked to remove her top and brassiere. Your child's/ward's back will be examined from behind while standing upright and while bending forward so that the doctor or nurse can screen for abnormal curvature of the backbone. If further assessment is required, your child/ward will be referred to the Student Health Centre.

3. Please note that all Primary 5 students will receive a home vision screening sheet for parent-administered vision assessments. Do note that this assessment is an estimate of your child's/ ward's visual acuity and is not a substitute for an eye examination by an optometrist or ophthalmologist.

7. The HPB requires the health booklet for students in Primary 1 and Primary 5 to be submitted. Kindly **submit the health booklet** to your child's/ ward's Form Teacher **by Friday, 13 October 2023**.
