## CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THE SURVEILLANCE ORDER UNDER SECTION 16(1) / SECTION 16(2) OF THE INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT (CAP 137)

## WHAT MUST BE DONE DURING THE SURVEILLANCE PERIOD

## **Undergo PCR Tests at Place of Isolation**

- 1. If you are issued a Quarantine Order (QO) to isolate at a place of isolation that is <u>not</u> your Residence or the dwelling place (e.g. a Government Quarantine Facility), you must undergo a PCR test, a medical examination which tests for the aetiologic agent of COVID-19, at or around the place of isolation, and on the dates specified in the QO. Arrangements will be made for you to undergo the PCR tests.
- 2. For the purpose of the PCR tests, you must provide your nasal, nasopharyngeal and/or oropharyngeal swab samples to the examiner carrying out the medical examination.

Spot checks will be carried out to ensure that you strictly adhere to these conditions under the Surveillance Order during the period specified. If you are found to be non-compliant, the Director of Medical Services may issue another order for your isolation and/or surveillance. It is an offence if you do not comply with the conditions listed above.
