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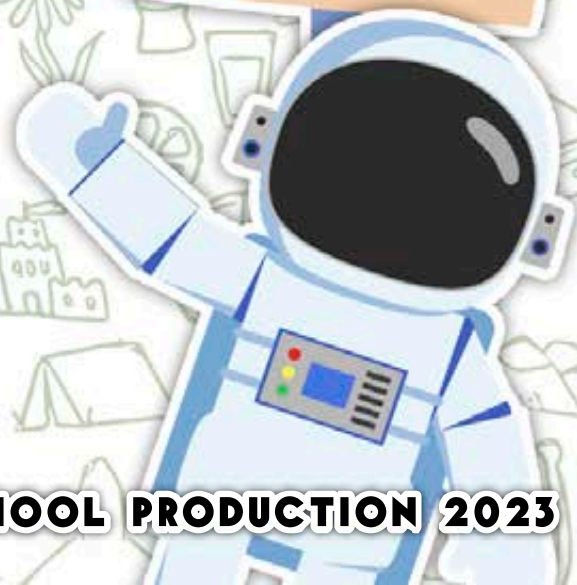

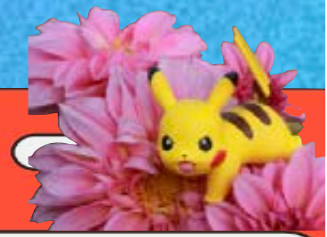

SWISS MISS UNICORN MARSHMALLOW HOT COCOA MIX

When it comes to camping, you might think of roasting marshmallows or hot chocolate. Well, why not have both of them together in one comforting drink? The packaging of the Swiss Miss Unicorn Marshmallow Hot Cocoa Mixes is colourful, eye-catching and hard to miss. On the back of the box, it even has a crossword puzzle to occupy campers who find it hard to sleep at night.

Making the hot chocolate is easy. Simply pour the cocoa powder into a cup, and add about 240ml of hot water. Mix well and stir in the packet of marshmallows. Despite the drink looking rather dull, it tastes creamy and perfect. I was pleasantly surprised upon trying it.

What I like about it is how fast it takes to make this hot chocolate and the rich flavour of this drink. However, it may be a little too sweet for some. The marshmallows are also rather dry so you may have to stir it in for about a minute. Also, it is rated Nutri-Grade D. Thus, it is not recommended as a daily drink.

On the whole, the Unicorn Marshmallows cocoa mix will be a tasty treat for not just campers but anyone who likes hot chocolate and squishy marshmallows. At a reasonable price of \$8.60 with six servings per box, you should go try it now!

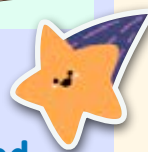
However, this treat can be a fun experience for children who like astronauts and would like a taste of eating in space!

3) What are 3 things you must take with you if you go on an adventure?

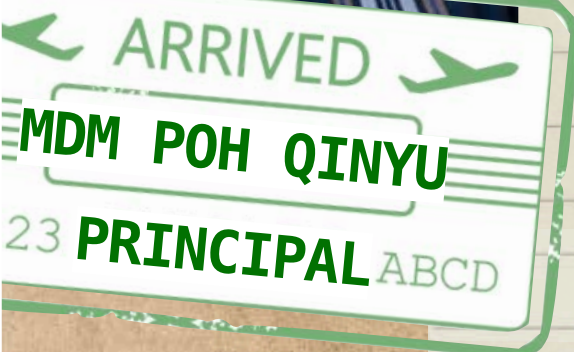
I would bring my phone, passport and credit card.

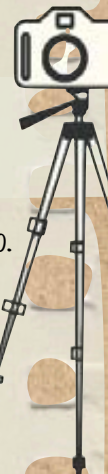
2. How do you feel when you travel to a new place and why?

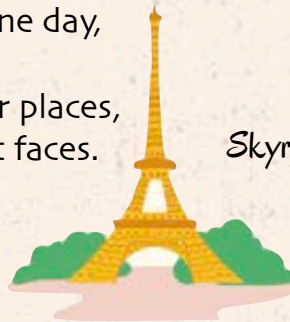

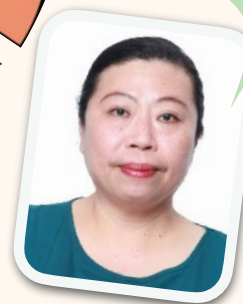
