## 3. Safe Management Measures

# a. <u>Implementation of TraceTogether-Only SafeEntry</u>

In tandem with the national roll-out, TraceTogether-only SafeEntry will be implemented in schools/institutions from 17 May 2021. From this date, check-ins would only be allowed via TT App/Token. Students should have their TT token or app with them throughout the school day to facilitate accurate contact tracing, should the need arise. As students will need to show their TT Token/App to their teachers in class during daily attendance and temperature taking, please ensure that your child/ward bring their Tokens/smartphones with the TT App to schools. Visitors, including parents/guardians of P1/P2 students who are fetching your child/ward from Parent Corner, must also check in using their TT token or app to be allowed entry into the school and must have their TT token or app with them throughout.

### b. Reminder on Social Responsibility

In light of the rising number of community cases in the recent weeks, we would like to seek the co-operation of all parents and students to play your part by continuing to be socially responsible. Please continue to practise good personal hygiene as well as monitor your own and child/ward's health. Students who are unwell











should seek medical attention immediately and do <u>not</u> come to school. You should also inform your child/ward's Form Teacher if you have:

- (i) any adult household members (18 years and above) who is unwell with flu-like symptoms;
- (ii) any household member who has been served Quarantine Order (QO) or Stay Home Notice (SHN): or
- (iii) any household member who has undergone a swab test.

Your child/ward may return to school upon the end date of the QO or SHN or upon the school's receipt of a negative swab test result.

### c. SMM During School Dismissal

Parents/Guardians are reminded of the following measures during school dismissal:

- Stand one-metre apart and DO NOT intermingle or congregate in small groups. Do also remind your helpers who are fetching your child/ward from school.
- Bring an umbrella as the waiting area is unsheltered.
- To minimise congestion at the traffic light area outside Gate 2, the school will open Gate 1 at 1.20pm. P1/P2 parents/guardians who are walking towards Eastpoint Mall can use this gate to exit the school.

Let us all work together to keep the school safe for all students and staff.

#### 4. Road Safety Reminders

# a. <u>Drop-off During Morning Peak Hours and Pick-Up During School Dismissal</u>

Despite the reminder inserted in last week's PN, the school observed that students continued to wait for parents/guardians to pick them along Simei Street 3.

Please heed both the "No Waiting" sign and the double yellow lines on the road which mean "No parking or waiting <u>at all times</u> on the road."

The traffic flow along this street during these peak hours is heavy. These pick-ups/drop-offs compromise the safety of road users as well as the safety of our students. Please drive into school (after 1.55pm for dismissal) if you need to drop-off or pick-up your child/ward.





# b. No Right-Turn from between 6am and 8am

During morning drop-offs, the school observed that drivers recklessly turned right when they exited the school compound despite warning from the security guard. Do note that turning right between 6am to 8am is a traffic offence and offenders will be reported to LTA.



Let's do our part to keep the school and its immediate surrounding safe for our students, staff and public.

## 5. Early Dismissal for Muslim Students on 12 May 2021, Wednesday

Students who are celebrating Hari Raya Puasa will be allowed to leave school at 10.05am (for P1/P2), 10.10am (for P3/P4) and 10.15am (for P5/P6) on Wednesday, 12 May 2021. Parents/Guardians must make the necessary transport arrangement for your child/ward. A separate notification has been sent through PG to affected parent/guardians on Tuesday, 4 May 2021. Please reply by **Monday, 10 May 2021**.
