## Home-Based Learning (HBL) Plan for Primary 1 to 3 from 28 June to 2 July 2021

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We will be having Home-based Learning (HBL) for our Primary 1 to Primary 3 students from 28 June to 2 July 2021 (Term 3 Week1).

## In helping your child/ward to prepare for HBL, please take note of the following:

- a) Files, books and other materials are being returned to your child/ward on 17 and 18 May. This is to ensure that learning continues when students do not come to school.
- b) Students will be required to <u>log into SLS every morning between 7 a.m. to 7.40 a.m.</u> for attendance taking. They will be required to do a short check-in in SLS.
- c) Please <u>adhere to the timings assigned</u>. This is to reduce the number of students logging in at the same time and also to reduce the load on the internet bandwidth when doing online work.
- d) If you have more than 1 child/ward sharing a device, you may adjust the timings to suit your needs. Some teachers may want to have synchronous lessons (where all students in the class log in together with the teacher or through video conference) with your child/ward and these teachers will inform your child/ward beforehand.
- e) The <u>duration of HBL for each day is 4 hours</u>, of which not more than 2 hours is spent on computer work (online work). Students will be assigned both online work and offline work. A good practice will be to have students jot down what their offline work is in their Student Handbook so they know what they need to do. Parents are to inform teachers if students need more time to complete HBL due to circumstances at home.
- f) To enhance the learning experience of students, teachers will be using various platforms for HBL, mainly through Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS) and Google Classroom, which is part of G Suite for Education. All login details can be found on **pg.137** of their Student Handbook. Please note that due to a high volume of users logging into SLS, it may take a while to log in. It is normal. If you are unable to log in, try again 2-5 min later.
- g) Should you need digital devices for HBL, please fill in this form <a href="https://go.gov.sg/hbldevice">https://go.gov.sg/hbldevice</a> Please note that this is only applicable for students who meet the following criteria:
  - i. students from households without computing devices suitable for HBL (including students who are using mobile phones for HBL)

- ii. students who have to share computing devices with household members
- iii. students without internet access at home
- h) If students are prompted to reset SLS password, please go to <u>https://go.gov.sg/resetslspassword</u> for instructions on how to reset the password on their own. This reset will be immediate.
- i) If students encounter login issues and/or unable to reset password for either SLS or Google Classroom/G Suite for Education, please fill up this form via this link <u>https://go.gov.sg/ckpsloginissues</u>. We will get back to you as soon as possible.
- j) If you encounter issues with the work given, please contact the respective subject teachers.

The learning activities will be designed to allow students to complete them independently. We encourage you to support your child/ward by providing an environment conducive for learning at home. You could do this by:

- Working out a daily schedule/routine with your child/ward and guiding your child/ward in setting goals and scheduling tasks.
- Establishing an agreement with your child/ward on managing screen time. We will assign a maximum of 2 hours of online learning every day. - Encouraging your child/ward to maintain an optimistic and positive outlook while accepting the changes and emotions that he/she has had to face as part of going through HBL.
