Tips for Parents

TRY THIS AT HOME!

Ask your child to observe how the sun looks and what it feels like at different parts of the day. Encourage them to use comparative, deductive language: "The sun was brighter and hotter at noon but darker and cooler in the evening." This activity encourages children to observe their


environment and make educated deductions as they

identify the difference of the sun's position relative to

time. Guide them along with prodding questions.
